Public Access to the West Australian Ballet Centre (WABC) – COVID-19

West Australian Ballet have implemented measures to ensure the safety of staff and patrons entering WABC.

These measures are currently in place and operations will increase if required:

- Hand sanitiser distributed throughout building, especially at doors and bathrooms;
- Cleaning and disinfecting public areas before and after performances, workshops and classes;
- Physical distancing measures are encouraged; and
- Disinfect public areas every day.

Further measures for Adult Ballet Classes participants include:

- You must sign-in on arrival with the SafeWA app, or on the paper register;
- Face masks are mandatory for all students and Teaching Artists/receptionists for the entire time you're at WABC;
- No cash payments accepted on the premises;
- It is recommended participants bring a full water bottle to class and where possible, be dressed and ready for class;
- Participants will have access to downstairs bathrooms only;
- Participants will only have access to the studio 15 mins prior to class commencing and must leave immediately once class concludes.

The following social distancing guidelines continue to apply:

- Stay home if you're sick. Do not come to class;
- Try to keep 1.5 metres away from others;
- Don't make unnecessary physical contact with others. Avoid physical greetings, such as handshakes, hugs and kisses;
- Wash your hands regularly for at least 20 seconds with soap and water and/or alcohol-based sanitiser;
- Cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze. Use a bent elbow or a tissue; if you use a tissue, dispose of it immediately and appropriately.
