Conditions of Entry

Admission to an event is at the discretion of West Australian Ballet representatives. West Australian Ballet reserve the right to refuse admission to, or eject any person who appears to be intoxicated, disorderly, offensive or otherwise fails to comply with West Australian Ballet's Terms and Conditions. Patrons who have been refused entry, can be prohibited from purchasing further tickets to West Australian Ballet performances. Damaged or defamed tickets may not be allowed entry, without recompense at the discretion of West Australian Ballet.

Patrons, at all times are required and expected to behave in a manner:

- Which is not defensive, offensive, humiliating, intimidating or threatening to any staff or patrons,
- That does not threaten the safety of patrons or staff,
- That does not cause damage to any property owned by the West Australian Ballet or Quarry Amphitheatre, or
- That does not interfere with or distract performers or surrounding patrons.

Please note patrons who behave in an inappropriate manner at any event, including but not limited to wearing or otherwise displaying any commercial, political or religious signage or materials that may reasonably cause offence can be refused entry.

No audio or video recorders (including mobile phones) may be used without the prior written permission of West Australian Ballet. A breach of this condition may lead to the confiscation of all equipment and/or the removal of the patron from the venue.

If in the instance patrons are refused admission for safety and security reasons outside of their control, a full refund will be issued.

Search and Inspection

To ensure the safety of all patrons and staff, West Australian Ballet reserves the right to inspect all bags and personal belongings upon entry. Searches will be carried out in a discreet manner. Any prohibited items (listed below) will be discarded or removed from the venue. Patrons who refuse this policy will not be allowed to enter the venue, no concessions or refunds will be administered for tickets purchased.

Prohibited Items

Prohibited items include but are not limited to:

- Illicit Substances
- Weapons, explosives, noisemakers (including megaphones)
- Laser devices
- Animals (other than hearing and assistance dogs)
