



## Notification of Proposed Works

Date: 28-03-2019

### *To The Occupier*

Dear Sir/Madam

WAURC will be carrying out crane lift works at 900 Hay St Perth on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> May and Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> May to remove the tower crane. This will require the closure of Hay St between King St and Milligan St from 0100 to 2100 hours on those dates (40 hours in total).

To do this, we are working with the City of Perth, Main Roads, Universal Cranes, Material suppliers, Workforce Road Services- Traffic Management.

### **What Are We Proposing to Do?**

We are proposing to close Hay St between King St and Milligan St as the crane will completely block the road. Access to street parking and Cloisters Car Park will be allowed from King St but only up to 900 Hay St. All vehicles exiting Cloisters Car Park, Wilson Parking 427 Murray St, Wilson Parking 216 St Georges Tce and His Majesty's Car Park will be directed back to King St by traffic controllers on site to leave the area.

### **How Will This Affect You?**

If you are using one of the car parks you may experience some delays leaving the area. If you are using Hay St you will be detoured onto King St and Murray St back to Milligan St.

#### *Pedestrian access*

A pedestrian diversion will be in place to direct all pedestrians to the southern side of Hay to pass safely around the work site.

#### *Vehicle access*

Only vehicles accessing on-street parking or the Cloisters Car Park will be able to proceed along King St into the closed section of Hay St. All vehicles within the closed section will only be able to leave the area by going back to King St and exiting through the closure point.

#### *Business/Residential access*

Access to local businesses will still be available for pedestrian traffic. If deliveries are scheduled for businesses within the closed section of Hay St they will not be able to be made during the works.

#### *Traffic Management*

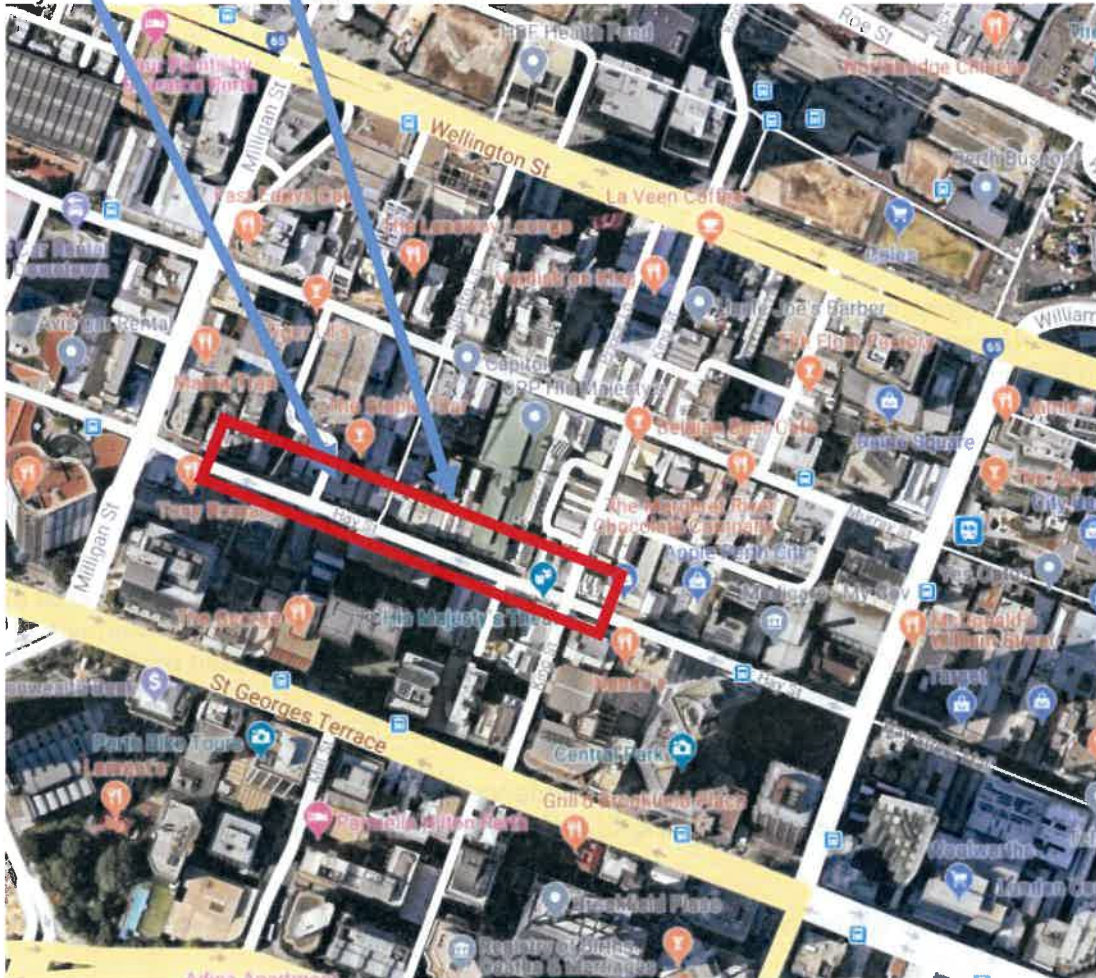
Workforce Road Services will assist in all movement in and around Site.
